COMPARING ENERGY RATES: A QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

What to Look For:

Price Per Unit

The price per unit you will pay for the gas or electricity you use—shown as \$/kWh for electric or \$/MCF or \$/CCF for gas.

Introductory Price

Is the price you are being offered only available for a limited time? Is the introductory price a "teaser" rate?

Early Termination Fee

The fee you will pay if you switch suppliers before the contract term ends.

Rate Type

Rate types include fixed, meaning it stays the same for the length of the term, or variable, meaning the rate can fluctuate.

Term Length


The amount of time you are locked into the contract. When the term ends are you automatically renewed and at what rate?

Monthly Fee

Some suppliers charge a monthly fee in addition to the price per unit.
